## You shall love your neighbor as yourself

The readings of this Sunday invite us to discover the importance of other people in our lives. Since a couple of Sundays ago, we have been walking the path of the disciples of Jesus; not merely as individuals but as members of a community, members of the Church that the same Jesus founded over the faith of the Apostles, represented in the profession of faith expressed by the Apostle Peter.

The Lord invites us to be united as brothers, to walk together and to grow mutually. Certainly, from our human experience we have realized that we as human beings have the need, care, and presence of others in our lives; from the moment of our arrival in this world, the care and help of others are indispensable, otherwise, our existence would be limited to a couple of hours.

In the same way, the spiritual and human support of the community become indispensable in our walk as disciples of Jesus; but the invitation to stay together or to live in community is not merely to obtain a personal benefit, but we also learn that participation in the life of the community generates responsibility for the care of others.

Today, we are invited by Jesus not merely to dwell on ourselves and our personal progress but to have the ability to include others in our lives and to care for them as if we were ourselves. Jesus certainly expects the best of us, and there is no better way than loving Him and loving our neighbor as ourselves.

De igual forma el apoyo y el acompañamiento espiritual y humano de la comunidad se vuelven indispensables en nuestro caminar como discípulos de Jesús; pero la invitación a permanecer juntos o a vivir en comunidad no es meramente para sacar un beneficio personal, sino que además esa participación en la vida de la comunidad nos genera la responsabilidad del cuidado también de los demás.

Hoy somos invitados por Jesús no meramente a quedarnos pensando en nosotros mismos y en nuestro progreso personal, sino a tener la capacidad de incluir a los demás en nuestra vida y a preocuparnos por ellos como si fuéramos nosotros mismos. Ciertamente Jesús espera lo mejor de nosotros, y no hay mejor manera que amándole a él y amando al prójimo como a nosotros mismos.
