TERMS AND CONDITIONS

AIR TRANSPORTATION: Round-trip coach class on American, Delta, United or other IATA member. Meals served in flight.

LAND TRANSPORTATION & SERVICES: By deluxe air-conditioned motor coach with professional driver, services of a bilingual Tour Director & local guides, all admission & entrance fees and transfers to and from international airports. Daily schedule with Mass as per your itinerary, however we reserve the right to modify any itinerary if circumstances deem necessary.

LODGING: First-class accommodations, based upon double occupancy with limited single accommodations available at an additional charge of \$500.

MEALS: Breakfast buffet and Dinner DAILY.

ALSO INCLUDED IN PRICE: All taxes, including airport taxes. Gratuities for tour directors, local guides, bus drivers, porters, wait staff, housekeeping and front desk personnel. Tipping will be conducted by a tour leader during the course of your tour.

NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE: The cost of obtaining your passport and visa fees to some countries, meals not included in the itinerary, wines, liquors, bottled waters, coffee or tea, personal items, laundry services, room service charges, long-distance phone calls, excess baggage, airport service charges and any sightseeing not included in the itinerary.

GROUP REQUIREMENT: The minimum number of passengers needed to assure a group's departure is 15. We reserve the right to cancel up to 30 days from departure should the total number of registered passengers be fewer than 15. If there are fewer than 15 passengers, Pilgrimage Tours will do all that is possible to assure your group's departure without having to resort to charging a supplemental fee for the group. If Pilgrimage Tours cancels, you will receive a full refund.

DEPOSIT AND FULL PAYMENT: A deposit/payment of \$500 towards the price of the tour, per person is required to book your reservation. The balance is to be paid in full 60 days prior to departure; August 16, 2017. Balances not paid by this date may be subject to a \$100 late payment fee. Reservations made within 30 days of departure may be subject to a \$100 late reservation fee. Upon receipt of your completed registration form and deposit, a confirmation invoice along with a travel insurance brochure will be mailed to you.

INSURANCE: Trip Cancellation and Interruption Insurance is highly recommended. Cancellation fees are covered by CSA Travel Protection's plan, as long as your premium has been paid, your policy is in effect and the reason for your canceling is insurable. Waivers for pre-existing medical conditions are available at no additional cost, but your policy must be purchased before your final payment for the tour.

CANCELLATION FEES: Passengers not taking the CSA travel insurance need to be aware of the following **cancellation fees.** From day of registration up until 60 days prior to departure, there is a non-refundable administration fee of \$50. The remaining cancellation fee schedule is as follows: 89-60 days = \$300; 59-46 days = 50% of tour price; 45-30 days = 75% of tour price; 29-15 days = 80% of tour price; 14 days or less = 100% of tour price.

DAILY MASS AT THE HOLY SITES

Fatima Apparitions 100 Year Anniversary Marian Shrines Pilgrimage to Portugal, Spain & France

Under the Spiritual Leadership of Fr. Duberney Villamizar

October 16, 2017 - Monday NEWARK / LISBON

Today we gather at Newark Liberty International Airport and board our flight en route to Lisbon, arriving the next day. Meals are served on board our transatlantic flight.

October 17, 2017 - Tuesday LISBON / SANTAREM / FATIMA

Today we arrive in Lisbon and meet our Pilgrimage Tours' tour director who will remain with us until the end of our tour. We transfer to the city of Lisbon, where we will enjoy a motor coach tour of Portugal's capital, including a visit to the birthplace of St. Anthony of Padua. En route to Fatima, we stop in Santarem for a visit and celebration of Mass at the Church of St. Stephen, or "Church of the Holy Miracle", site of a 13th century Eucharistic miracle. Finally we arrive in Fatima where in 1917 Mary appeared to the young, local children and the "miracle of the sun" occurred. This year marks the 100th anniversary of the Fatima Apparitions. Following dinner we participate in the evening's Candlelight Procession. Overnight in Fatima.

October 18, 2017 - Wednesday FATIMA

This morning we participate in the Stations of the Cross along the path that the shepherd children used to tend to their flock en route to the Cova de Iria where Our Lady appeared to

the children. Here we pause to recite the Holy Rosary. Next we visit nearby Aljustrel to visit the House of Lucia and House of Francisco and Jacinta. In the afternoon we will visit the Shrine and Basilica of Our Lady where we celebrate Mass, followed by a visit to the shrine's museum and free time to explore the sanctuary's grounds. Following dinner this evening, we have another opportunity to join the Candlelight Procession. Overnight in Fatima.

October 19, 2017 - Thursday FATIMA / SANTIAGO de COMPOSTELA

Today we depart Fatima for the home of St. James, Santiago de Compostela. Upon our arrival in Santiago de Compostela, we enjoy a walking tour of the historic center of Santiago de Compostela, including a visit to the Romanesque and Baroque Cathedral of St. James the Apostle, which houses the remains of the Saint James. Following Mass in the Cathedral of St. James, we arrive at our hotel for dinner and overnight in Santiago de Compostela.

October 20, 2017 - Friday SANTIAGO de COMPOSTELA / AVILA

This morning we travel to Avila, perhaps the best-preserved walled city in the world and home of St. Teresa of Avila who with her spiritual director St. John of the Cross, reformed the Carmelite Order. We celebrate Mass at the Carmelite Monastery of the Incarnation, where we will also see the cell where St. Teresa lived. Next we arrive inside the ancient walls of Avila and visit the Church of St. Teresa where we will see more relics of St. Teresa. Dinner and overnight in Avila.

October 21, 2017 - Saturday AVILA / MADRID / ZARAGOZA

This morning we depart Avila for Madrid, where upon our arrival, we enjoy an orientation tour of Spain's capital that will include a visit and celebration of Mass in Madrid's Almudena Cathedral. Following Mass, we enjoy free time for shopping in the Plaza Mayor, Madrid's main square. We bid

Madrid farewell and continue on to the town of Zaragoza for dinner and overnight.

October 22, 2017 - Sunday ZARAGOZA / LOURDES

This morning we visit the Basilica of Our Lady of the Pillar, the place where Mary appeared to the Apostle James before her Assumption into heaven. Following Mass at the basilica, we continue on to Lourdes where in 1858, Mary appeared to a young Bernadette Soubirous. Upon our arrival in Lourdes, we enjoy a walking tour of Lourdes where we visit the places important in the life of Bernadette, including the Grotto and Spring where Mary appeared to Bernadette numerous times. We see the nearby Healing Baths where many pilgrims submerge themselves for its healing properties. We also visit the Basilica of the Immaculate Conception (Upper Basilica) and the Rosary Basilica (Lower Basilica) as well as the Basilica of Pius X, followed by visits to Bernadette's home and the Museum of Lourdes. Following dinner we participate in the evening's Candlelight Procession. Overnight in Lourdes.

October 23, 2017 - Monday LOURDES / BARTRES / ST. SAVIN

This morning we celebrate Mass in the Crypt of the Basilica of the Immaculate Conception (Upper Basilica). Next we will explore the countryside known by St. Bernadette with a trip into the snowcapped Pyrenees Mountains. First we visit Bartres, where Bernadette lived and then we will make a stop to visit the old Benedictine Abbey in the village of St. Savin. We return to Lourdes and gather together for walking the Stations of the Cross. The remainder of the day is free at the Lourdes Sanctuary where we can explore its holy grounds. This evening offers another opportunity to participate in the Candlelight Procession. Overnight in Lourdes.

October 24, 2017 - Tuesday LOURDES / BARCELONA

Early this morning we celebrate Mass at the Poor Clares Convent, followed by breakfast before departing Lourdes for Barcelona, where upon our arrival we enjoy a motor coach tour of this cosmopolitan city, including a visit to its impressive Basilica of the Sagrada Familia, one of the largest churches in Europe. Here we will learn of the history of the basilica, including its initial ground-breaking in 1882 and its construction which became the life's work of Antoni Gaudi until his death in 1926. Our day concludes with our arrival at our hotel in Barcelona for dinner and overnight.

October 25, 2017 - Wednesday BARCELONA / MONTSERRAT

This morning we embark on a day trip to the wonderful mountaintop sanctuary of Montserrat and enjoy some of the most incredible scenery in Spain. Upon our arrival we enjoy a tour of the Monastery and grounds where we see the Statue of Our Lady of Montserrat or Black Madonna, probably Spain's most fervent devotion to the Blessed Mother. Following Mass at the Shrine, we enjoy free time for lunch. We return to Barcelona and arrive for a visit to its Gothic Quarter and the famous Las Ramblas Boulevard, one of the most upbeat and striking boulevards in all of Europe. Here we will enjoy free time for shopping in Barcelona's many shops and cafes. Dinner and overnight in Barcelona.

October 26, 2017 - Thursday BARCELONA / NEWARK

After breakfast, we transfer to the airport for our return flight back home. Though our pilgrimage draws to a close, its blessings will last a lifetime and its graces are certain to draw us closer each day to the Lord.
